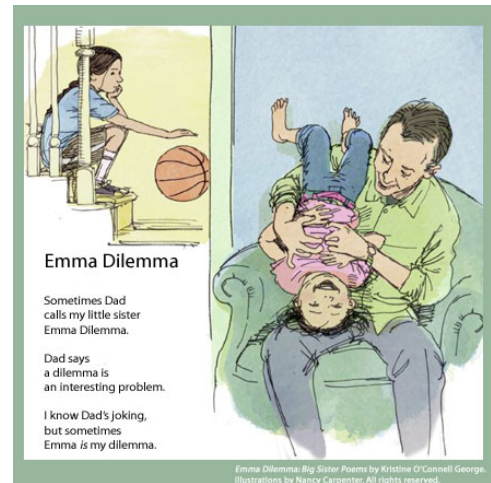


Dear Reader,

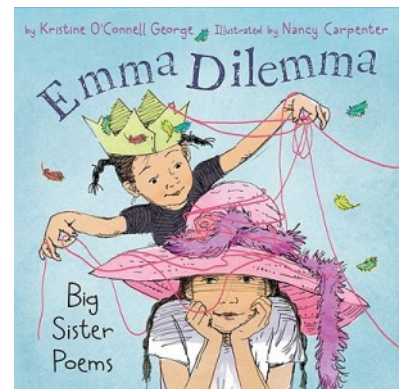
